

Adventure: I'll Do It Myself

Objective Scout will Achieve:	Learning skills by watching older siblings or adult parents, learning to take care of themselves and their personal belongings, and increased autonomy among Lion Scouts
Characteristics Scouts will Learn:	Character Development, Participatory Citizenship, and Personal fitness
Materials for Virtual Meeting:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials for gathering activity: simple household materials (blocks, cups, cardboard boxes, dominoes, cards) • For Activity 1: reusable grocery-type bag; decorations such as fabric, markers, scissors • For Activity 2: Lion Adventure Book and colored pencils • For Activity 3: one shoe with laces
Activities during meeting:	Gathering activity- Stackathon, Lion Scout bags, Personal Care Checklist, and Tying Shoelaces
Instruction for Activity 1	Gathering Activity- Stackathon: Using simple household materials, challenge your Lion to create the tallest stack by him/herself.
Instruction for Activity 2	Lion Scout Bags: Provide your Scout with a reusable grocery-type bag to decorate with assistance from you. Decorations can be made of fun foam and glued on, drawn with markers, cut out of fabric and attached, etc. Cookie cutters provide easy patterns for drawing shapes.
Instruction for Activity 3	Personal Care Checklist: Create a list of tasks a Lion Scout does for him/herself. Partner with your Lion Scout and use the list to create a personal care checklist for the Lion.
Instruction for Activity 4	Tying Shoelaces: Give your Lion one shoe with laces for practice in tying the laces. Celebrate success, and offer encouragement to your Scout if they are still learning!
Additional Requirements needed to complete the Adventure (These requirements will not be on the Virtual Cub Scout Video):	Look in Lion Adventure Book for Meeting 2 Plan (Den Outing) when you are able.
