

## Adventure: Mountain Lion Meeting 2

Objective Scout will Achieve:	Demonstrating how to be respectful of the natural environment
Characteristics Scouts will Learn:	Character development, personal fitness, outdoor skills and awareness, leadership
Materials for Virtual Meeting:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Lion Scout homemade Six Essentials Kit</li> </ul>
Activities during meeting:	Learning Hike, Pick Your Spot, Discussion
Instruction for Activity 1	<p>Learning Hike: take a short learning hike. The distance should be consistent with the age and physical ability of your Lion Scout. The hike can be in a rural location or a local city/state park.</p> <p>-Before leaving on the hike, share the “S” rules with the group:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sticks stay on the ground</li> <li>• Stones stay with the sticks</li> <li>• Stay on the path</li> <li>• Stay with your buddy</li> </ul> <p>A learning Hike is a themed hike that encourages the Scout to look for certain things, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How many animals or animal homes can you find?</li> <li>• How many items can you locate that would fit on a penny?</li> <li>• How many colors did you see?</li> </ul>
Instruction for Activity 2	<p>Pick Your Spot: During a rest break on your hike, play Pick Your Spot. Partner up with your Scout and pick a spot to stand in. Discover something in nature that demonstrates our five senses- something we hear, smell, touch, see, and taste (a hike snack is best for taste, or they can imagine they are an animal and play that way). Can the Lions find something for all five items?</p>
Instruction for Activity 3	<p>Discussion: Guide a discussion about respect for our animal friends and their homes. Help them discover what it means to have a low impact on the areas we visit- we don’t litter, we don’t cut or pick flowers, we don’t pick up rocks and move them, we leave things as we see them without disturbing them, etc.</p>
