Include: Name, Den Level, Hometown and Pack Number if you are in one.)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) What are the defining characteristics of a musical instruments? 2) What are lyrics? 3) What is melody? 4) Why are these needed in order to make music?
Activities during meeting:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Make a musical instrument. Play it for your family, den, or pack. 2) Teach your den the words and melody of a song. Perform the song with your den at your den or pack meeting. 3) Create original words for a song. Perform it at your den or pack meeting. 4) Perform a musical number by yourself or with your Webelos den in front of an audience.
Instruction for Activity 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) What you'll need (make your own tambourine): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. 2 heavy-duty paper plates ii. Hole punch iii. String or yarn iv. Jingle bells v. Markers or crayons <p>What you'll do:</p> 2) Hold two paper plates face to face and punch holes around the perimeter of the plates about an inch and a half apart to string your yarn. 3) Take your length of yarn and weave it up through a hole, around the outside and back up the same hole again and tie a knot to secure the plates together. Then, string a jingle bell through your yarn and continue weaving your plate. Alternate your jingle bells every other hole or more, depending on how many bells you have. 4) When you get back to the hole in which you started, tie off your yarn again and let your child decorate his DIY instrument to make it his own. Then, shake to

	<p>play and your kid’s instrument is ready for the big show!</p> <p>Drumset: You will need:</p> <p>cans balloons rubber bands dowels and beads for drumsticks (optional)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Empty out cans. Make sure they’re washed and dry. 2) Cut apart a balloon, make sure it can cover the top of the can. 3) Wrap a rubber band around the top of the can to secure the rubber band. 4) Tap it. What kind of sound does it play? 5) Try again but with different sizes of cans.
